- The certificates are no longer valid and shall not be used for any conformity declarations.
- Products covered by this certificate may not be placed on the market under this certification after the withdrawal date.

Manufacturer Obligations After Withdrawal

As the manufacturer, you are required to:

- Cease use of the withdrawn certificates in all documentation, labeling, and marketing materials (including websites).
- Ensure that no products relying on these certificates are placed on the market after the withdrawal date.
- Maintain traceability records for products already placed on the market for the legally mandated retention period.
- Implement corrective actions if required by market surveillance authorities.
- The manufacturer remain responsible for compliance with all applicable legal requirements.

KEMA B.V. Documentation and Traceability

KEMA B.V. will retain all relevant documentation per Directive 2014/32/EU, ISO/IEC 17065, and EU law for the required (mandated) period, and make it available to authorities (like the EU Commission, Member States) on request.
